
Middle School Drop-Off and Pick-Up Traffic Flow



## Middle School Drop-Off and Pick-Up Traffic Flow

- Safety is the number one priority in the drop-off/pick-up circle.
- Watch for students in the crosswalk as you enter and exit the traffic circle.
- Students may only exit/enter cars at the sidewalk (anywhere along the west side of the building -- from the gym to the stop sign). Students should be prepared to exit cars as soon as the car is stopped safely beside the sidewalk and not wait to be closer to the door.
- Students may <u>not</u> walk through the traffic circle.
- Proceed through the starred (\*) handicapped parking spots if space is available beyond them.
- Do not jump the line when spaces appear. Be patient as drivers in front of you pull forward.
- If the line reaches the parking lot entrance to the old DPW building, parents will form a circular line-up inside the parking lot to get traffic off of Route 27. Students must be picked up on the sidewalk next to the gym, and may not meet rides in the DPW parking lot.
- Once you have dropped-off/picked-up your student, you may cautiously pull out, away from the curb and around waiting cars to exit.
- Stop at the stop sign as you exit the traffic circle. Oncoming traffic (buses, staff members, and others not turning into the traffic circle) does not have a stop sign and you must **yield** to this traffic.

Drivers – for safety, no cell phone use while moving through the Traffic Circle!
