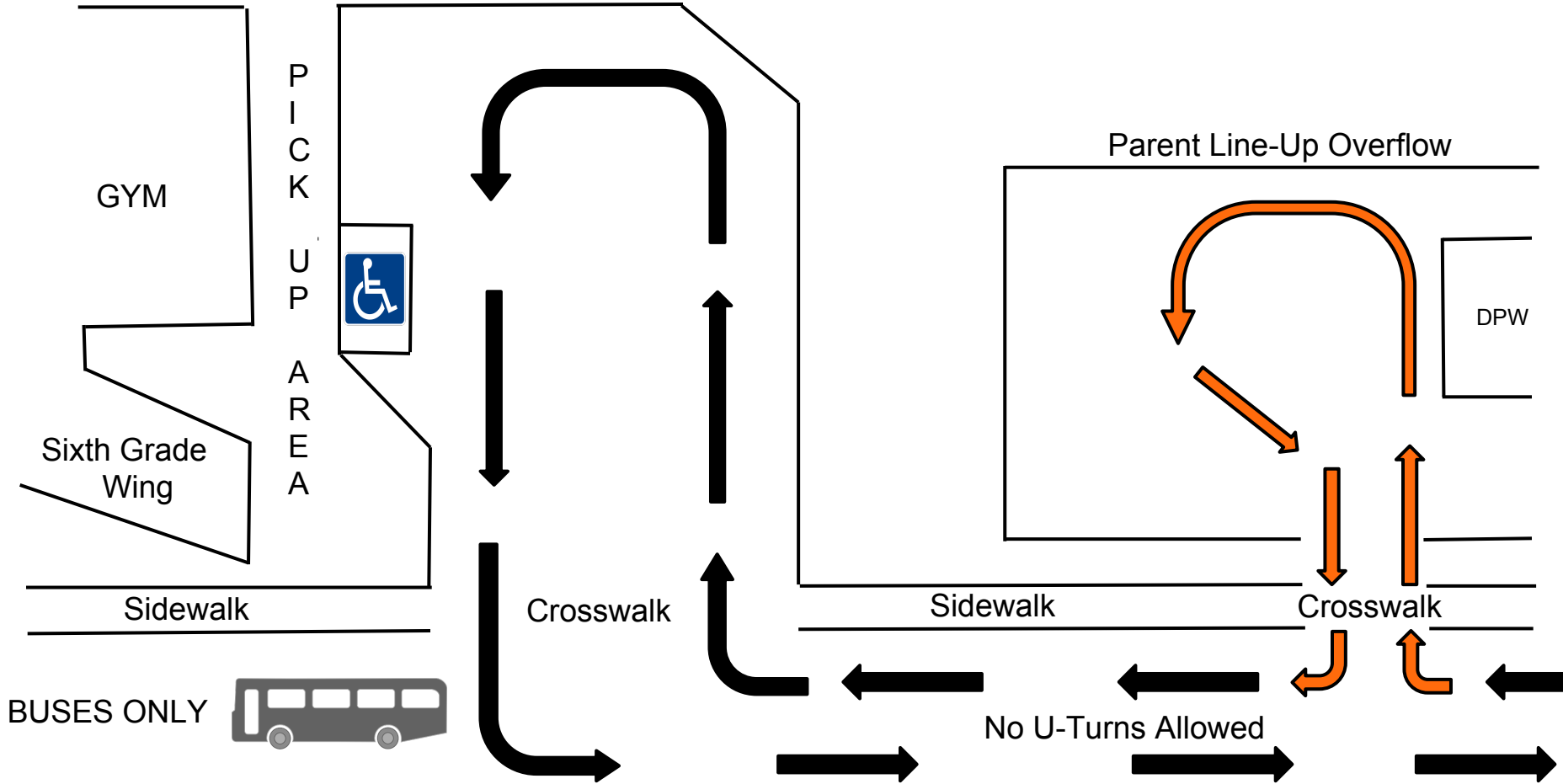


# Middle School Drop-Off and Pick-Up Traffic Flow



## Middle School Drop-Off and Pick-Up Traffic Flow

- **Safety is the number one priority in the drop-off/pick-up circle.**
- Watch for students in the crosswalk as you enter and exit the traffic circle.
- Students may only exit/enter cars at the **sidewalk** (anywhere along the west side of the building -- **from the gym to the stop sign**). Students should be prepared to exit cars as soon as the car is stopped safely beside the sidewalk and not wait to be closer to the door.
- Students may not walk through the traffic circle.
- Proceed through the starred (\*) handicapped parking spots if space is available beyond them.
- Do not jump the line when spaces appear. Be patient as drivers in front of you pull forward.
- If the line reaches the parking lot entrance to the old DPW building, parents will form a circular line-up inside the parking lot to get traffic off of Route 27. *Students must be picked up on the sidewalk next to the gym, and may not meet rides in the DPW parking lot.*
- Once you have dropped-off/picked-up your student, you may cautiously pull out, away from the curb and around waiting cars to exit.
- Stop at the stop sign as you exit the traffic circle. Oncoming traffic (buses, staff members, and others not turning into the traffic circle) does not have a stop sign and you must **yield** to this traffic.

**Drivers – for safety, no cell phone use while moving through the Traffic Circle!**
